Accessory items may be put within five ft. of property line, should be increased.
Would like to have buffer section more defined.

Delores Leistikow-

Does not want a home to back up to her property; she lives here because it is in the county.

Virginia Behrens-

Why annex? **Answer** to obtain water and sewer to area.

Keith Perry-

Will Village put in sewer lines? **Answer** No, developer will get the process started.

John Rogers-

Roger's home property will never be developed, as long as he has something to say about it.
Preserving green space is a priority
